BCA's Senior Inter District Cricket Tournament Season 2022-23

Advisory to District Cricket Associations/Zone Officials/Observers

As per the discussion held with various District Cricket Associations and the subsequent decision of the Cricket Tournament Committee, In League Phase *38 Districts are divided into 8 Zones named as

1. Angika Zone
2. Mithila Zone
3. Patliputra Zone
4. Western Zone
5. Sahabad Zone
6. Seemanchal Zone
7. Central Zone
8. Magadh Zone

Six (6) Zones will have Five (5) Teams and Two (2) Zones will have Four (4) Teams based on Vicinity and Convenience in travel. All Matches will be played in League (50 Overs/Side) Super League (3 Days) and Semifinal and Final will be of Four Days.

League Phase

Every Team of a Zone will play against each other In a 50 Overs per side One-day match.

The top Team from each Group will qualify for Super League Round.

- A Combined Team (Rest of the Zone) will be formed from the players from the remaining Teams of the Zone on the basis of their performance in the League Phase and performance in the BCCI's Domestic Tournament of Season 2021-22 and 2022-23.
- The rest of the team will be selected by BCA appointed Observer of the zone in the consultation with Zonal Convener/Committee. The rest of the Zone Team will consist of a maximum of 20 players. This Rest of Zone Team will also play in Super League along with the Top Team of the Respective Zone.
- The performance of players in the League Phase will be considered only for Selection in the Rest of the Zone Team.
- The performance of players in the Super League onwards will be considered for the Selection of 66 players for State Camp.

Every District **Must Register a Maximum of 30 Players and a Minimum of 15 Players, 2 Days before the commencement of the tournament** and Submit the list in the prescribed format along with all documents and must submit the Hard Copy to GM Cricket Operation – Mr Sunil Kumar Singh. Registration of Players Shall Be Done Only Once No Further Addition Will Be Entertained In Any Condition.

Super League - Super League will have 16 Teams in 4 groups with 4 Teams in each group.

- 8 Zonal Champion Districts will qualify for the Super League stage and 8 Rest of the Zones Teams will play in Super League. The Super League Matches will be of 3 Days with a maximum of two Innings on each side with a provision of a minimum of 90 Overs per day.
- For Smooth and Successful conduct of the Tournament, BCA will reimburse the expense of Balls, Transportation, Lodging & Food of Visiting Team, Umpires, BCA's appointed Observers, Preparation of Grounds and Field Expenses for the match.

It's Mandatory for every player to participate in BCA Domestic Inter District Tournament, Only Those Who will participate in the tournament will be considered for Camps and BCCI's Domestic Tournaments in Season 2023-24. Players not participating in this Tournament will not be considered for Camps and Selection of Teams for **BCCI's Domestic Tournaments in Season 2023-24.**

- Note - Only Those Players who will be participating in BCCI assignments like Matches/NCA etc. Camps will be exempted from matches falling during that period.
- 66 Players will be selected for Camps on the basis of their performance in the Super League to the Final as well as their performance in BCCI Matches Season 2022-23.
- Only these shortlisted 66 players will be considered for selection for BCCI Matches in Season 2023-24 In Senior and U-25 Groups. The composition of 66 players is:
 - I. Batter-30
 - II. Spinner -12
 - III. Fast Bowler-18
 - IV. Wicket Keeper-6

Note - In case the required number of performers/Quality players in any Specialty is not available then Performers/Quality players from other specialties will be considered in the List of 66 Players for Camps.
