Sub: regarding implementation of Justice Lodha Committee Recommendations

Dear all.

As per the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 18/07/2016 and subsequent orders dated 07/00/2017, 02/01/2017, 03/01/2017, 20/01/2017 and 24/01/2017 for the successful implementation of Justice Lodha Committee Recommendations, you are hereby requested to fulfill the following conditions:

- Uniformity of structure the number of elected office bearers in the committee of management should only be '5' and the posts would be
 - 1. President
 - 2. Vice President
 - 3. Hony Secretary
 - Hony Treasurer
 - 5. Joint Secretary
- Tenure of each office bearer would be of 3 years with a maximum of three such terms regardless of the post held.
- Individuals disqualified for holding any of these posts, if he or she:
 - 1. Is not a citizen of India;
 - 2. Has attained the age of 70 years;
 - Is declared to be insolvent, or of unsound mind;
 - 4. Is a minister or a government/ public servant
 - Holds any office or post in a sports or athletic association or federation, apart from cricket;
 - 6. Holds more than one post at a given point of time at any level in affiliated cricket unit

Therefore, you are kindly requested to make the required changes based on these recommendations and give us the report within 21 days from the date of issue of this letter, so that it could be forwarded to the apex council.
