The Chairman asked to table the letter/communication in which the CoA of BCCI has raised objection regarding the **“Provisions/Deviation / Typographical Errors / Additions made in Bihar CA’s Rules & Regulations”** and required addition as **verbal instructions /objections of the office of IG, Registration, Bihar Patna** for approval of amendments in Rules & Regulations of Bihar CA recommended by COA, BCCI in compliance of order of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

In physical absence of, the CEO, The Acting Secretary, Mr. Kumar Arvind tabled the same. **It is resolved unanimously that Joint Secretary shall work as Secretary / Acting Secretary and sign all relevant documents regarding amendment of memorandum and rules & regulation of Bihar Cricket Association.**

The Members in House after going through the objection raised by the CoA of BCCI, unanimously agreed to rectify the "Provisions/Deviation / Typographical Errors / Additions made in Bihar CA's Rules & Regulations which are not according to provisions of BCCI Rules & Regulations and even violating the judgment dated 9th August, 2018 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Civil Appeal no.4235 of 2014 & connected matters.

The House unanimously decided to rectify the deviations of BCA Rules & Regulations, to rectify as requirements/objections of office of IG, Registration Bihar.


