Advertisement for Selectors & Support Staff-Season (2026-2027)

Due to an inadequate response to the earlier advertisement, the Bihar Cricket Association (BCA) again invites applications from eligible and qualified candidates for engagement as Selectors for the 2026-2027 domestic cricket season.

Applications are invited for the post of Selector for the Bihar Cricket Association (BCA). The eligibility criteria for the post of Selector are as follows:

01.	The Men's Selection Committee (Selectors for Men's Senior)	The Applicant must have retired from the game of Cricket at least five (05) years before the date of publication of this advertisement. Only former Players of BCA who have played: 1. India in Test/ODI/T20 Or 2. Minimum of Three (3) Ranji Trophy Matches. Or 3. Minimum of Five (5) BCCI Senior One-Day Matches. (An applicant from any member association of BCCI may apply as per Hon'ble Supreme Court Order dt. 27-10-2025)
02.	The Junior Cricket Committee (Selectors for Men's Junior-All Age Groups)	The Applicant must have retired from the game of Cricket at least five (05) years before the date of publication of this advertisement. Only former Players of BCA who have played: 1. India in Test/ODI/T20 Or 2. Minimum of one (1) Ranji Trophy (Multi-Days) match Or 3. Minimum of Three (3) BCCI One-Day (List A) Matches (An applicant from any member association of BCCI may apply as per Hon'ble Supreme Court Order dt. 27-10-2025)
03.	The Women's Selection Committee (Selectors for all Women's Categories)	The Applicant must have retired from the game of Cricket at least five (05) years before the date of publication of this advertisement. Only former Players who have played: 1. India in Test/ODI/T20 Or 2. Represented the Women's Bihar State Team



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Instructions, Terms & Conditions for Applicants:

1. Applicants are required to submit their applications strictly in the prescribed format attached herewith, clearly mentioning the post applied for, along with a brief resume and a recent colour photograph. Applications must be sent via email to info@biharcricketassociation.com, or the hard copy should be submitted in a sealed envelope superscribed with the name of the post applied for, addressed to:

The applications must reach us on or before 25th July 2026.

2. The applicants shall be solely responsible for the authenticity of the documents and information submitted along with the application. If any information furnished is found to be false, incorrect, or misleading at any stage, appropriate action shall be taken against the applicant.
3. Every applicant shall mandatorily mention the date of his/her retirement from all forms of cricket in the resume/Curriculum Vitae submitted along with the application. Applications not containing this information may be liable to be rejected.
4. Applicants who have already submitted their applications earlier in response to the previous notification for the post of Selector are not required to submit a fresh application. Their earlier applications shall be treated as valid and will be considered for the selection process.
5. An applicant may apply for a maximum of three posts only, which should be clearly mentioned in the order of preference.
6. A list of qualified candidates shall be prepared, and such candidates may be called for scrutiny/verification of their documents and further selection process. Qualified candidates shall be informed individually through email, WhatsApp, telephone, or through the official website of the Bihar Cricket Association regarding the date, time, and venue of the scrutiny/verification/interview process.
7. No TA/DA or accommodation shall be provided by the Bihar Cricket Association for attending the scrutiny/verification/interview process.
8. The provisions relating to Conflict of Interest and the Code of Conduct of the Bihar Cricket Association and the Board of Control for Cricket in India shall be applicable and binding upon all applicants.
9. Any form of canvassing or influencing in any manner shall lead to the automatic rejection of the candidature.



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10. The Rules and Regulations of the Bihar Cricket Association, as amended from time to time, shall be applicable.
11. In the event it is found at any stage of recruitment, employment, or contractual engagement that an applicant has submitted false information, fabricated documents, or suppressed material facts, the BCA reserves the right to reject the candidature or terminate the engagement forthwith. The BCA shall also be entitled to cancel the contract agreement and recover any remuneration/fees already paid and impose such penalties as may be prescribed under the Rules and Regulations of the BCA. Applicants are advised to carefully review the "BCA/BCCI Conflict of Interest Rules" before applying.
12. As per the Rules and Regulations of the BCA, the Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the BCA shall have the discretionary power to appoint/select the Selectors of various Selection Committees, including Men's Senior, Junior, and Women's Selection Committees.
13. The BCA reserves the right to create additional posts, apart from those notified, without any prior notice.
14. The BCA reserves the right to cancel any or all vacancies, partially or entirely, without assigning any reason thereof.
15. The BCA reserves the right to reject any application found unsuitable, incomplete, or containing misrepresented information, without assigning any reason thereof.
